2 Now, it may be in the end there will be some
3 plaintiffs' counsel who are not going to want to settle,
4 in which case then we'll see what happens in that
5 situation.

6 But hopefully as many of the non-settling
7 plaintiffs' counsel will agree ultimately to the
8 settlement -- or a settlement.

9 MR. McCUNE: Your Honor, Richard McCune.
10 Can I just address what happened in the
11 meetings?

12 THE COURT: Sure.

13 MR. McCUNE: Quickly, so the Court will
14 know.

15 THE COURT: Yes.

16 MR. McCUNE: I -- Mr. Carey's office took
17 two of the interviews and I took one of them.

18 How the process went is we went forward.
19 There were two designees from the non-settling parties
20 that were there, and they were taking questions from the
21 20 or 25 non-settling counsel who were on the phone.

22 We took frequent breaks in which we were
23 provided questions. Ninety-five percent of the
24 questions we were comfortable going forward.

25 At the conclusion of our presentation, where

1 we continually interfaced with non-settling counsel and
2 asked most of their questions, then non-settling counsel
3 had a designee who asked all the questions that we
4 didn't and went until they were concluded.

5 The process really worked quite well. And
6 from our perspective, we asked almost all of the
7 questions that were presented to us. Those that we
8 weren't comfortable asking or didn't think were
9 relevant, then non-settling counsel designee asked.

10 So I think the impression that this process
11 was fragmented isn't correct. I think it went forward
12 pretty smoothly.

13 THE COURT: All right.

14 MR. BONSIGNORE: Your Honor -- sorry.

15 THE COURT: Let me just stop counsel. At
16 this point in time, I do not want to resolve what
17 happened on the 4th or 5th. That is water under the
18 bridge virtually.

19 And so I do understand, however, as I have
20 indicated, that there may be some reopening as to
21 certain areas which are of importance.

22 Again, however, you know, this is -- you
23 know, let's not waste everybody's time and money asking
24 questions which were already asked unless there's
25 something specific that is problematic.
